**Life-Saving Programs Suspended:**

Over 2.4 million people in Ethiopia's Tigray region depend on U.S. food assistance grown by American farmers that now sits abandoned in ports while desperate families go hungry.

20 million people living with HIV across 55 countries have lost access to services through PEPFAR.

328,000+ HIV positive people across 28 countries at high risk of transmission have lost access to HIV treatment and testing.

A 90-day pause in PEPFAR could result in more than 100,000 HIV-related deaths in the next year.

## Infectious Disease Programs Paused:

Experts warn that cutting health assistance to Africa removes America's first line of defense against deadly pandemics.

Bird flu monitoring and detection programs in 49 countries have been cut off precisely at a moment when bird flu is tearing through the U.S. and driving up the cost of eggs.

Short gaps in malaria prevention activities – like distribution of bed nets – can cause devastating effects.

In the middle of a deadly Mpox outbreak in the Democratic Republic of Congo, testing and treatment services are being stopped at 73 testing sites and 92 health facilities that serve 200,000 people.



**U.S. INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE KEEPS DEADLY DISEASES AT BAY. THAT MAY CHANGE.**

Uganda is fighting a new Ebola outbreak, but health programs are at risk with supply chains halted.

The vast majority of Mpox vaccine doses pledged by the U.S. are stuck in a warehouse and can't reach those who need them.

Ending other critical global health programs could lead to an additional 200,000 cases of paralytic polio per year, and more than 28,000 cases of dangerous infectious diseases such as Marburg and Ebola.
